GDC's dress code requirements are designed to support an optimal dance experience for all students. Dressing the part allows the dancer to be fully prepared for the demands of class, ensures safety, and sets the tone for the level of focus while instilling a sense of confidence and pride in the dancer's appearance.

Ballet Tights	Convertible ballet tights without seam. GDC Recommends: -Body Wrappers Total Stretch Convertible Tights -Capezio Ultra Soft Transition Tight	GDC recommends choosing ballet tights that best match the dancer's skin tone: -Pink/Peach -Tan/Caramel -Brown/Espresso	Dancemax Dancewear	-Panty hose or fashion tights should never be worn in place of ballet tights made by a dancewear provider. -Ballet tights and shoes should color match as closely as possible.
Ballet Shoes	Canvas or leather ballet shoes w/ full or split sole. GDC Recommends: -Bloch Ladies Performa Stretch Canvas Ballet Shoe -Body Wrappers 4-Way Total Stretch Ballet Slipper (Angelo Luzio) -Capezio Canvas (Hanami Ballet Shoe)	GDC recommends choosing ballet shoes that best match the dancer's skin tone: -Pink/Peach -Tan/Caramel -Brown/Espresso	Dancemax Dancewear	-Shoes should fit snugly to avoid a tripping hazard. We highly recommend purchasing from a dancewear provider to ensure quality dance shoes that will last through the year. -Ballet tights and shoes should color match as closely as possible.



Dress Code: Pre-Primary Division

Additional Dress Code Requirements (Females)	
Cover Up	An appropriate “cover up” (i.e. additional clothing that fully covers the dancer’s uniform) is required when coming to and from the studio. Please do not allow your dancer to walk outside in only their leotard and tights. DANCE SHOES SHOULD NEVER BE WORN OUTSIDE THE STUDIO.
Hair	Long hair must be secured in a ballet bun with a ponytail holder, hair pins, and/or bobby pins; short hair must be secured with a headband and/or clips so it stays out of the face.
Jewelry	Only small earrings allowed; no watches, or other jewelry (necklaces, bracelets, or rings) allowed.
Undergarments	Traditionally the female dancer’s ballet tights and leotard act as undergarments and support (i.e. underwear is not worn underneath the tights or leotard, similar to a bathing suit). If you feel additional undergarments are needed for added support or coverage, we recommend they be purchased from a dancewear provider when possible (i.e. made specifically for dancers) and should be discreet and completely hidden by the uniform.
