GDC's dress code requirements are designed to support an optimal dance experience for all students. Dressing the part allows the dancer to be fully prepared for the demands of class, ensures safety, and sets the tone for the level of focus while instilling a sense of confidence and pride in the dancer's appearance.

Additional Dress Code Requirements (Females)	
<b>Cover Up</b>	An appropriate "cover up" (i.e. additional clothing that fully covers the dancer's uniform) is required when coming to and from the studio. <b>Please do not allow your dancer to walk outside in only their leotard and tights. DANCE SHOES SHOULD NEVER BE WORN OUTSIDE THE STUDIO.</b>
<b>Hair</b>	<p><b>Ballet:</b> Long hair must be secured in a ballet bun with a ponytail holder, hair pins, and/or bobby pins; short hair must be secured with a headband and/or clips so it stays out of the face.</p> <p><b>Jazz/Tap:</b> Long hair must be secured in a bun or ponytail for jazz or tap class; short hair must be secured with a headband and/or clips so it stays out of the face.</p>
<b>Jewelry</b>	Only small earrings allowed; no watches, or other jewelry (necklaces, bracelets, or rings) allowed.
<b>Nails</b>	Fingernails should be kept trimmed to a reasonable length; <b>long nails and fake nails/nail extensions are not allowed in dance class.</b>
<b>Undergarments</b>	Traditionally the female dancer's ballet tights and leotard act as undergarments and support (i.e. underwear is not worn underneath the tights or leotard, similar to a bathing suit). If you feel additional undergarments are needed for added support or coverage, we recommend they be purchased from a dancewear provider when possible (i.e. made specifically for dancers) and should be discreet and completely hidden by the uniform.
