



RECITAL FAQs

How do I purchase tickets?

- Tickets are \$15 each and available for purchase at georgiadance.com. For more information, please read our [ticket policies](#).

Will there be general admission or reserved seating?

- This year there will be reserved seating for GDC's Recital 2022. Please be prepared to show your ticket to the ushers, either via phone or a printed version.

My child is 2 years old or younger...do they need a ticket?

- They do not need a ticket as long as they can sit on your lap.

How long is each show?

- Each show will run approximately 1 hour long with no intermission.

Does my dancer need to wear a mask?

- Masks are optional. If your dancer does wear a mask during the recital, the mask should match their skin tone.

Where can I find my Recital time and date?

- You should have already received your **Recital Confirmation** page by email, which lists dates and times for your dancer's recital and dress rehearsal.
- You can also find your Recital Time and Dress Rehearsal time by logging in your Studio Director Account.
- You may also search your dancer's name on the ticketing website when you are purchasing recital tickets.

Where can I find my dancer's dress rehearsal time?

- Rehearsal times can be found on your Recital Confirmation page in the "Notes" section. You can view the GDC Recital 2022 Dress Rehearsal schedule [here](#).

Where is the location of the recital and dress rehearsals?

- GDC's Recital 2022 will be held at the Marietta Performing Arts Center (MPAC) at Marietta High School.

What time should my dancer arrive for their dress rehearsal?

- Dancers should arrive 20 minutes prior to their dress rehearsal time in full costume and makeup. Arrival times are on your dancer's recital confirmation page.

What time should my dancer arrive for their recital?

- Dancers should arrive in full costume and makeup 30 minutes prior to the start of the show.
